High-end Sports Bar Capitol City Adds to Cahuenga Corridor Gets Collegiate

The Infamous Crawl Welcomes High-End, Collegial Feel

The old Goa space on Cahuenga is getting the executive treatment, transforming on September 9th into **Capitol City**, a high-end sports bar replete with all the necessary (\$3 million) fixings—plasmas, draught beer chilled and served at a consistent 31 degrees, 30-foot bar, 7,000 square feet, etc., etc.

The Tag Front-designed space (the firm behind **Katana**, downtown's **Takami** and the new Luckman Plaza **BOA**)

leaves little to be desired with 45 60"-65" plasmas, a 14'x8' hi-def 1080p screen with individual Sounddog wireless speakers available at each table, indoor-outdoor dining and a menu courtesy of chef Shad Davis (**The Belmont**, the Counter, Stone Fire Pizza).

There are two downstairs patios with the streetside one having sliding floor-to-ceiling windows, which means easy access to the street's continually rewarding people watching, while the 1,000-square-foot back patio has its own bar, two private cabanas and a large central table made for optimal, sports viewing since there will be multiple 60-inch flatscreens outside as well.

Cap City also has a full bar, a variety of signature cocktails, a private, VIP mezzanine level, six separate dining/viewing areas and even its own English pub, all a far cry from its previous Bollywood-meets-Hollywood incarnation. The high-end, East Coast-y bar will no doubt shift the hipster-iffic vibe of the Corridor to more fratastic fraternizing.
